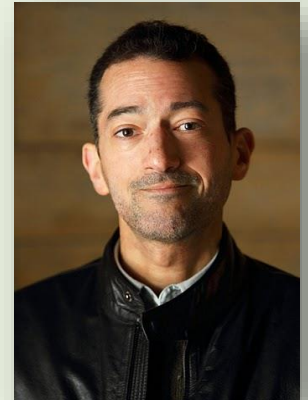

### “Racial Health Disparities in the United States and Florida”

- Dr. Kaufman’s research focuses on social epidemiology, health disparities, epidemiologic methods, causal inference, and international health.
- His work addresses the Black vs. White inequality in health within the US. This is a long-standing concern that has been monitored and studied for decades.
- In this presentation, Dr. Kaufman will discuss research in this field from a biomedical and demographic perspective and discuss some debates on the scientific principles underlying the research.
- He will also present recent findings on heterogeneity between US states on magnitude of inequality in life expectancy and it’s trends over time, with a focus on Florida’s trends.
